STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Turtle Mountain School Division believes that every student has the right to attend a school that maintains a safe and caring learning environment. It is expected that all students will demonstrate behaviour which models respect, positive citizenship, and self-discipline at all times. All schools will develop a student code of conduct in accordance with Turtle Mountain School Division policies and procedures, the Manitoba Public Schools Act Section 47.1 (1), 47.1 (2) – 47.1.1(6), the Education Administration Act, Section 4(1), (p2), (p.3), Manitoba Regulation 77/2005, Safe Schools Regulation, Section 6, Bill 18, The Public Schools Amendment Act (Safe and Inclusive Schools), Provincial Code of Conduct – Appropriate Interventions and Disciplinary Consequences (January 2014), and the Manitoba Human Rights Code. School codes of conduct will be reviewed with students and shared with parents on an annual basis.
