## PROGRAM NOT OFFERED: ROOM AND BOARD SUPPORT

A student must reside more than 80 kilometres from the school they wish to attend to be eligible for board and room support.

Any student wishing to attend an out-of-division school for a program not offered must have approval of the Superintendent of Turtle Mountain School Division as well as the Superintendent and Principal of the receiving division/school.:

For the purposes of this policy/procedure, a program not offered which would qualify for room and board support will include language programs such as French Immersion, accredited vocational programs such as Hairstyling, Carpentry, Autobody, Electrical, Welding, or a program approved at the discretion of the Superintendent.

Students will qualify for room and board support only if the student is enrolled in a full language or accredited vocational program. A confirmed student timetable will need to be submitted to the Superintendent for review and approval prior to room and board being provided.

## A.

Room and board costs to a maximum of \$6,000 will be reimbursed in circumstances where room and board has been approved. This amount will be paid in \$600 monthly instalments upon the receipt of proof of attendance each month at the school.

Mileage will not exceed the transportation grant supplied by Manitoba Education.
