



Regular Board Meeting March 6, 2019

Turtle Mountain School Division Board Meeting Highlights

-Trustees received information regarding the possibility for the Manitoba Winter Games to be hosted in Killarney and Boissevain in 2022. This will be confirmed in January 2020.

-The Superintendent provided an update on the request from Turtle Mountain Adult Education Centre to partner with Regional Connections Immigration Services in Winkler, MB to provide services to families and students of immigrant families.

-Trustees received an update regarding ongoing communication in relation the provincial review of public education, including postcards which will be mailed to citizens within Killarney, Boissevain, and Minto.

-Wellness Fairs will once again be taking place in Killarney on April 17 and Boissevain on April 24, 2019. The Wellness Fairs continue to be very well attended and are very beneficial in building an early connection between the schools and the families of children who will soon be entering kindergarten.

-The Assistant Superintendent has been in discussion with representation from the Killarney Elks regarding a potential donation the Elks may be willing to make to support equipment for the Killarney School sensory room. A presentation will be made to the Elks on March 12, 2019.

-The Secretary-Treasurer reported that the annual request for proposals will go out to financial institutions in March, 2019.

-Manitoba School Divisions are no longer required to conduct a PSAB audit annually, this will save TMSD approximately \$3500 each year.

-The Board of Trustees passed a motion approving the 2019-2020 Frame Budget.

The Board of Trustees passed motions approving the following revised policies: I-1 (Child Protection), I-2 (Student Accidents), I-3 (Health and Wellness), and I-5 (Use of Physical Restraint).
