Turtle Mountain School Division Board Meeting Highlights

-Trustees received confirmation that the annual Employee Recognition Dinner will occur at the Killarney Golf Course on June 13, 2019.

-Trustees and senior administration made final preparations for the presentation which will be made to the provincial education review commission on May 9, 2019.

-Trustees received information in regards to the new Canada Food Guide, including an upcoming information session which will be attended by school personnel.

-An update was provided regarding the Pre-School Wellness Fairs which occurred in Killarney and Boissevain Schools on April 17 and 24, 2019. Both fairs were very well attended and successful, with 110 children participating in both communities combined.

-TMSD student services personnel received professional development from Dr. Gordon Neufeld on April 10, 2019. Topics focused on supporting students who have experienced trauma, and who may be suffering from anxiety or depression. Dr. Neufeld also focused on what students need to in order to be resilient and bounce back from trauma.

-Trustees received recommendation regarding proposals submitted by financial institutions to offer financial services to the school division in 2019-2020.

-Trustees reviewed and discussed the financial statements as of April 30, 2019, including the projected surplus for June 30, 2019.
