Frequently asked QUESTIONS...

Where is the wind chill factor reader located?

The wind chill reader used by the Division is located in Boissevain and read by CJRB staff.

Why is the wind chill so cold before you close?

A wind chill of -45° C is in use in a number of divisions and is in the range of dangerous conditions for transporting students.

Why is the announcement not on the radio until 6:45 a.m.?

Every effort is made to have the announcement on the radio as soon as possible. However, some circumstances may prevent all radio stations from being contacted earlier than 6:45 a.m.

CANCELLING BUSES/CLASSES

The Transportation Coordinator and Superintendent/CEO will be in contact with each other between 6:00 a.m. and 6:20 a.m.

If at 6:20 a.m. the temperature reaches -45° C with the wind chill, buses/classes will automatically be cancelled. Other factors such as visibility and road conditions may also indicate that cancellation of buses/classes is warranted.

By 6:25 a.m. the Superintendent/CEO will be in contact with the Transportation Coordinator and together the final decision will be made prior to 6:35 a.m.

By 6:45 a.m. the Transportation Coordinator will contact the radio stations if buses/classes are cancelled and the Superintendent/CEO will update the TMSD website (wwww.tmsd.mb.ca).

RESPONSIBILITIES

Parents/Legal Guardians:

When buses/classes have not been cancelled, the final decision as to whether the child goes to school or not is up to the parent/ legal guardian. If a student is kept home during inclement weather they will not be penalized for missing school or exams. Parents/legal guardians must ensure the school has a current storm billet for their child.

Staff:

When buses/classes have been cancelled, staff are expected to attend their worksite unless a collective agreement provision is available that specifies otherwise.

Division:

The Division will decide if buses are cancelled. When buses are cancelled for safety reasons, classes are always cancelled as well. The Division never runs classes when buses have been cancelled as more than half of our students are transported.

What if the buses are cancelled during the school day?



In some cases, buses must be cancelled while classes are in session.

Buses will not be sent out early. This is to avoid delivering students home unexpectedly.

Students will be delivered (by bus if possible) to their storm billets in town.
