

ADULT EDUCATION FUNDING

In cases where there are students under the age of nineteen years that are attending one of the Turtle Mountain Adult Education Centres a transfer of funding will occur for each student if the following criteria are met:

1. The student is under the age of 19 years, and;
2. The student attends one of the Turtle Mountain Adult Education Centres and is registered at a high school in the Division.

The amount of funding that will be transferred is equal to the total of the following:

- The “Instructional Support” in the base support category of the Funding of Schools program provided the student is registered in a school in the Division as of September 30.
- Base Funding Grades 9-12: \$275/FTE student
- Curriculum Materials: \$30/FTE student
- Information Technology: \$50/FTE student
- Level II funding
- Level III funding

The amount of funding transferred to Turtle Mountain Adult Education will be pro-rated based on the proportion of programming taken at the Centre and the proportion of the school year spent at the Centre.

The Turtle Mountain School Division will charge the Turtle Mountain Adult Education Centre for annual administration costs to a maximum of \$10,000 per annum.

The maximum surplus that the Turtle Mountain Adult Education Centre can carry-forward is \$2,000.
