

STANDARDS TESTS AND EXAMINATION

Where Manitoba Education has determined that students will write provincial standards tests, all students will be required to write such tests, unless exempt according to guidelines.

Where the Province requires that a percentage of the standards test be used to determine a student's final grade, students, will write a final test to replace the provincial examination if it was not written. The test results will contribute to the student's final marks based on the provincial percentage identified for that grade.

Optional standards tests will be written at the discretion of the Division. A decision on the use and the marking process to be followed whether individual teacher, school based or divisionally based will be communicated to schools prior to the end of October each year.

Where it is determined that optional standards tests will be written, students will write the tests and they will contribute to the students' final marks based on the provincial percentage suggested for that test.
