

ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Turtle Mountain School Division believes that having international students participate in the educational process in Turtle Mountain School Division can have a positive effect on schools and students. Turtle Mountain School Division may from time to time accept fee-paying international students. International students will be accepted on the following conditions:

- i) The agent or individuals recruiting on behalf of Turtle Mountain School Division have submitted evidence that the necessary documentation to allow the student to enter Canada and Manitoba as a student have been completed.
- ii) The necessary medical insurance, and other insurance as required by the Board of Trustees, are in place.
- iii) The student is registered and that the tuition has been paid in accordance with the guidelines of the program.
- iv) The tuition fee charged to international students shall be, comparable to those paid by international students in other Manitoba school divisions.
- v) Students must reapply each school year for acceptance into Turtle Mountain School Division's programs.
- vi) The Board may provide additional school staffing support if there are a significant numbers of international students in a school. Any staffing adjustment will not normally occur prior to the end of September.
- vii) The parent(s)/legal guardian(s) and international student agree to abide by the Division's Code of Conduct.
