

COMMUNITY SERVICE CREDIT POLICY

Turtle Mountain School Division believes that students can make a contribution to the community by volunteering for worthwhile causes or organizations.

The civic skills, knowledge, and attitudes obtained from such community service can increase a student's self esteem and maturity and provide more awareness of the needs of others in the community.

A student may earn 1 optional credit through community service. The credit will be registered as a SIP (Student Initiated Project). The Community Service Credit will be designated a 31 G course for 1 credit.

The Division will also establish administrative guidelines for use when approving Community Service Credits. Refer to 4-M of the Administrative Manual.
