

DISTANCE LEARNING COURSES (GRADES 9 – 12)

The Board encourages students to take advantage of the instructional time and courses in the schools. However, students may on occasion choose to take distance education courses for a variety of reasons.

Students attending schools who wish to take distance learning courses must meet two stipulations:

- a) the applications must be signed by the school administration. If the application is not approved, this matter may be appealed to the Superintendent.
- b) the application must be signed by a parent/legal guardian if the student is under the age of 18.

Registrations for Distance Education Courses for credit purposes may be approved for any of the following reasons:

1. courses not offered at the school of attendance
2. desire for extra credit(s)
3. extenuating circumstances

Students may not be enrolled in a school course and registered for the same course through Distance Learning for credit purposes at the same time.

Students are responsible for the payment of tuition fees for all Distance Learning Courses.

Reimbursement will be made to students upon successful course completion for credit purposes.

The Division will not assume the costs for subject aides or for course auditing.
