

INTERNET ACCESS POLICY

The Turtle Mountain School Division encourages administration, staff and students to use technology to enhance the teaching and learning process. The following guidelines apply:

1. All students under the age of eighteen years are required to have a signed parental/legal guardian permission form – Internet Access – returned to the school granting them permission to use the Internet. As students transfer schools, this permission form will be transferred to the receiving school.
2. Students above the age of eighteen are required to complete an Internet Access Form agreeing to comply with the rules governing Internet use established by the Division and the school.
3. New students are required to have the form 4-W signed and returned to the school prior to accessing the internet.
4. Employees are required to sign and return 4-X to their supervisor prior to accessing the internet.
5. Responsible use of the Internet is expected. All users will access only educationally appropriate sites.
