

COMMUNICABLE/BLOODBORNE COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Turtle Mountain School Division recognizes its responsibility to protect the health and safety, rights, and privacy of the entire school community regarding transmission of communicable and blood borne communicable diseases.

Turtle Mountain School Division recognizes the rights of staff and students to work and learn in a safe environment. Therefore, staff and students who have acquired a communicable/blood borne communicable disease may continue their presence at work/school providing that this has not been forbidden by health authorities and providing that appropriate safety precautions, as directed by health authorities have been implemented. Students who are excluded from school shall have access to alternate educational opportunities.
