

MEDICAL PROTOCOL

1. Turtle Mountain School Division is committed to meeting the educational needs of all students. In order to meet the diverse needs of students a continuum of supports for health care services has been developed.
2. Turtle Mountain School Division endorses and supports the guidelines and procedures outlined in the provincial Unified Referral Intake System (URIS). Plans for students with Level A or B health needs will follow the URIS procedures. (Refer to Turtle Mountain School Division Administration Manual Section 8A).
 - Turtle Mountain School Division acknowledges that certain students may require administration of prescribed medication during the school day. Administration of medication is subject to the conditions outlined in the Medical Protocol – Administering Medication to Students (p.7)
 - Turtle Mountain School Division has incorporated procedures from the Unified Referral and Intake Systems (URIS) and the Canadian School Boards Association for students with known risk of anaphylaxis and/or life threatening allergies. The Medical Protocol contains information on awareness, avoidance and emergency procedures.
