## Literacy Teacher Leader Position Description

Working closely with senior and school administration, the Literacy Teacher Leader will provide leadership and hands-on classroom literacy support for all schools within the division. The Literacy Teacher Leader will support colleagues through coaching and co-teaching in the areas of instructional planning, implementation, and assessment to assist in maximizing student achievement across grade levels and subject areas. Responsibilities:

## 1. Serve as the division representative for any regional/provincial meetings pertaining to literacy development, including curriculum, instruction, and assessment.

- 2. Lead divisional and school teams/committees in ongoing improvement efforts to maximize student literacy achievement.
- 3. Provide leadership in ensuring literacy development efforts within the division are research-based and aligned with best practices.
- 4. Ensure ongoing data analysis is used to determine progress in literacy achievement, as well as identify strengths, challenges, and next steps.
- 5. Provide in-classroom support through coaching and co-teaching, in an effort to strengthen instructional practices.
- 6. Coordinate divisional/school teams to receive professional development based on regional/provincial literacy efforts, including but not limited to Manitoba Education and Training as well as the Manitoba Rural Learning Consortium.
- 7. Provide regular updates to school and division administration, focusing on progress as well as next steps for continuous improvement.
