E-DESIGNATION

- 1. The E course designation identifies any significant adaptations to curriculum goals and objectives or outcomes of 50% or more undertaken to accommodate the special learning requirements of EAL students.
- 2. The E-Designation is to be applied on an individual course basis.
- 3. An IEP is required for all students participating in one or more E-Designation courses.

M-DESIGNATION

- 1. This course designation may apply to Grade 9-12 students.
- 2. The M course designation identifies any department-developed or approved curriculum that has been modified for student with significant cognitive disabilities (< 80 FSIQ).

Significant is defined as modifications in curriculum goals and objectives or outcomes of 50% or more.

- 3. The educational team makes the decision to apply (or not apply) this designation.
- 4. This designation is course specific. (Example: A student may have an M designation in one or more courses, but not necessarily all courses).
- 5. An IEP is required for every student taking an M designation course.

I-DESIGNATION

- 1. This course designation may apply to Grade 9-12.
- 2. An individualized programming (I-Designation) is intended for students whose cognitive disabilities are so significant that they do not benefit from participating in curriculum developed/approved by Manitoba Education and Youth.
- 3. I-Designation signifies a full educational program, not a course by course designation.
- 4. Individual course marks are not required at the department level. Twenty-eight credits are not required for formal graduation. A provincial diploma is issued to an I-Designation students who has participated in a minimum of 4 years of Individualized programming during his/her high school years.
- 5. An IEP and ITP are required for every student taking individualized programming.
- 6. The "I-Designation" is determined by the educational team.
