Job Hazard Analysis/Safe Work Procedures		
Supervisor to provide: (i.e. training, protective equipment)		
A half-face respirator with a *NIOSH-rated N100, P100, or R100 air filter, Nitrile gloves, sealable plastic		
bag or pill bottle, and eye protection.		
Employees will: (Identify steps of the Safe Work Procedure)		
<b>Step 1:</b> No more than 5 to 6 square centimeters should be collected.		
Step 2: If more than one layer of material is present, the sample must include material from each layer.		
Step 3: While collecting a sample, only employees required should be present.		
Step 4: employees taking samples must wear, at minimum, a half-face respirator with a *NIOSH-rated		
N100, P100 or R100 air filter, gloves and eye protection.		
Step 5: While collecting a sample, the sample must be held away from the face. Samples are to be placed		
in a sealable plastic bag or pill bottle for transportation to the lab for testing.		
Step 6: Suspect materials must be sprayed with a light mist of water to prevent fibre release during		
sampling.		
Step 7: Each sample must be marked for identification. The Maintenance Supervisor shall be responsible		
to arrange for the Supervisor of Transportation/Designate to receive all samples.		
Step 8: The Supervisor of Transportation/ designate will arrange required testing.
