DISTANCE LEARNING COURSES (GRADES 9 –12): COVID-19 MEDICAL
ACCOMMODATIONS

Students who are unable to attend school due to COVID-19-related risk factors may access remote learning options. These situations should be rare and limited to children with compromised immune systems or other medical conditions that increase their risk. Parents and caregivers must consult with health care providers on the need for accommodation. This option can be available if health care providers have concern for immediate family members in a shared household where they cannot physically distance. A doctor’s note will be required.

Students K-8: The Manitoba Remote Learning Support Centre will provide remote learning for Kindergarten to Grade 8 students who are medically advised not to return to in-class learning due to COVID-19-related risk factors.
